Procedural Matters:

Fact Finds:

GBR 75 approached the downwind mark from the right side of the course with PUR 14 overlapped inside. As GBR 75 entered the three length zone NED 1 was at least one boat length astern on starboard gybe coming from the left side.

GBR 75 slowed down and altered course to give PUR 14 mark room. PUR 14 gybed and rounded the mark ahead of GBR 75.

NED 1 gybed to port and gained an overlap inside GBR 75 inside the three length zone, and then rounded the mark inside GBR 75

GBR 75 altered course to give NED 1 room. There was no contact.

No boat took a penalty.

Conclusion and Rules applicable:

NED 1 clear astern at the zone failed to give GBR 75 mark room, breaking rules 18.2(b)

Decision:

NED 1 is disqualified from Race 2
