GBR 124 was overlapped with USA 142 approaching the zone prior to the leeward mark. USA 142 was travelling faster but did not overtake GBR 124.

GBR 124 rounded the mark inside USA 142.

There was no contact between the boats.

No boat took a penalty.

## Conclusion and Rules applicable:

The international jury has reasonable doubt that USA 142 broke the overlap with GBR 124 prior to entering the zone under rule 18.2(d). No boat broke a rule

## Decision:

Protest is dismissed.
