



# 2015 POOL USAGE POLICY

## ROYAL NOVA SCOTIA YACHT SQUADRON

On behalf of Management of the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron we would like to notify our members and their guests that our Pool Usage Policy will be in effect for both the Clubhouse and Saraguay pools.

### MEMBER ACCESS:

Upon first visit to either pool, members will be required to pick up their Pool Access Bands at the main Squadron Pool. These **WHITE BANDS** will provide members and their dependants with access to the pool for the 2015 season.

### ACCESS FOR MEMBERS & THEIR GUESTS:

Guest Bands are to be signed out from the main Squadron Pool upon the guest's arrival each time they visit. These **GREEN BANDS** must be returned at the end of the day to the pool staff or lifeguard on duty.

- Senior members and Saraguay members will be allowed 5 guest band signouts per season
- Intermediate members will be allowed 3 guest band signouts per season
- Junior members will be allowed 2 guest band signouts per season
- Outport members will be allowed 1 guest band signout per season

### ADDITIONAL SIGNOUT BANDS AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE:

Above member categories may purchase additional guest band signouts at the main Squadron Pool at the following rates:

Adults - \$5 ea. /visit

Children - \$3 ea./visit

### FAILURE TO RETURN GUEST BANDS:

In the event that guest bands are not returned by the end of the day, the member who signed the guest band out will be contacted. Should the band not be returned in a timely fashion, a fee may be applied to the member's account.

### SARAGUAY POOL ACCESS FOR MEMBERS & THEIR GUESTS:

Members and their guests using the Saraguay pool are to wear their access bands. Members are reminded that the Saraguay Pool is to be locked at all times when not in use. Please lock it when you leave. The combination is available in the member's only section of the RNSYS website.
