DREW MITCHELL

Drew Mitchell grew up sailing at the Lunenburg Yacht Club in Nova Scotia. He has raced on and coached high-performance one-design for nearly 20 years, now with NorthU. Drew races in the Melges 24, Farr 30, Bluenose, and Martin 242 fleets and has won the Farr 30 North Americans and Melges 24 PNW championship. He came in 3rd at Martin 242 North Americans and was in the Top 3 in the Bluenose class for the last 4 years at Chester Race Week. Drew's distance racing experience includes winning the Van Isle 360 and racing the 2017 Transpac on a TP 52.



RYAN ANDERSON

Ryan Anderson grew up sailing at RNSYS and has represented Canada at major international regattas since he was a child. Currently Ryan is on the Canadian Sailing Team and is campaigning for the 2024 Paris Olympics in the ILCA 7 (Laser Standard Class). Out of the Laser Ryan enjoys racing keelboats at RNSYS and has spent the last five years coaching with the RNSYS race teams.

Paul Tingley is a five-time Olympian and boasts three medals two bronze in the Sonar class and a gold in the 2.4mr class.

RNSYS HIGH-PERFORMANCE CLINIC - J22 MATCH RACING

Dates: May 17 (evening), May 18, 19, 20 Cost: Members \$200 Non-Members \$250

The RNSYS High-Performance Clinic is an opportunity for athletes to take their sailing to the next level with world-class coaching provided by leaders in sailing. This clinic will bring together sailors from across Canada to learn from the best of the best.

Each day training will be run by our experts with the support of RNSYS' top-level race management and coaches. Following training, there will be individual group debriefs and then clinic-wide debriefs and presentations from performance coaches, ex-Olympians, members of SailGP, and America's Cup racers.

Breakfast snacks will be provided each day and there will be clinic-wide dinners on May 17 and 19 - all included with registration.

A short and fun introduction to Sailing. Ever wanted to try sailing but not had a way to get out? RNSYS' Try Sailing! program is for you. Each session will teach some of the basics of sailing while you take in a cruise of Halifax's beautiful Northwest Arm. These sessions are designed to be a one-off introduction to the sport.

You will be accompanied by an experienced sailing instructor on the boat who will do all the preparation so you can maximize your two hours on the water.

INTRODUCTION TO KEELBOAT SAILING

Sessions: Saturday and Sunday 9:00am to 4:00pm both days. Cost: Members \$275 Non-Members \$340

Learn all the basics of keelboat sailing from one of our experienced and Sail Canada-certified instructors. You'll learn all that you need to know to safely depart the dock, get the sails up, and head on your way!

This two-day course will cover the basics of direction and propulsion on a keelboat while also reviewing how to safely get your boat on its way.

Each day you will meet at 9am, the instructor will provide an introduction to the concepts that will be covered that day and then you will hit the water! You'll return over lunchtime for a complimentary meal in the RNSYS dining room before heading back out for more fun on the water.

BASIC CRUISING STANDARD

Times: 5:00pm to 8:00pm for 2 Friday evenings & 2 Weekends 9:00am to 4:00pm Each Day (Saturday+Sunday)

Cost: Members \$1,000 Non-Members \$1,250

Sail Canada's Basic Cruising Standard Course is a great way to develop all the skills you need to safely take your own boat out. This course covers the basics of sailing as well as navigation, anchoring, docking and the safe operations of your boat's engine.

The goal of the standard is for all participants to be able to cruise safely in familiar waters as the competent crew of a sloop-rigged keelboat of 6 to 10 meters with an outboard or inboard motor in moderate wind and sea conditions by day. The focus of this Standard is on the development of crew-oriented basic sailing skills, seamanship, and knowledge needed to act as a competent crew.

Course A: May 3,4,5 & 24,25,26 Course B: June 14,15,16 & 21,22,23 Course C: July 26,27,28 & August 2,3,4

REGISTRATION & CANCELLATION POLICIES

Cancellation Policy

- 1. A confirmation email will be sent to all applicants upon receipt of registration. Once this confirmation email has been sent, participant interest in attending the course is assumed unless the RNSYS is informed otherwise.
- 2. If, upon receipt of registration, a course is full the applicant will automatically be waitlisted. A waitlist email notice will be sent out to applicants who have been placed on a waitlist.
- 3. If space comes available, waitlisted registrants will be automatically notified of the availability.
- 4. Once confirmed, all registrations are subject to a 25% cancellation charge. Cancellations received within two weeks prior to the course are subject to a 50% cancellation charge. No refund is provided following the start of the course unless in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the RNSYS sailing director.
- 5. Any registration credits provided are non-transferable and must be used by the participant's family.

Registration Policies

- 1. Membership discounts are available to SENIOR members only.
- 2. Discounts are applied by participants inputting their membership status into the online system. Those found to have misrepresented their membership status will be required to pay the discount balance or will forfeit their registration and fees.

- 5.A minimum of three (3) participants are required for any adult LTS course to run.

HST

We are required to charge HST on all instructional courses and race programs offered to individuals 14 years of age and over at the time of the course, unless the individual is disabled. When HST is applicable it will be noted in the course profile. When payment is received without HST included, but it is applicable, the sender will be contacted to remit the HST.

Membership is not required to participate in our programs but it does offer year-round access to the RNSYS and discounts on registration!
